CLUB RULES INCORPORATING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The following are rules, terms and conditions relating to the Tuesday Business Club and are subject to change as the Organisers decide. All changes will be notified to the Club membership.

1. Tuesday Business Club meetings will be held at The George Hotel, Wallingford on the second Tuesday of every month. Reasonable notice of change of venue will be given.
2. Meetings are open to members and non-members.
 - a. Members pay £15.00 to gain entrance to the meeting. This fee includes drinks and light food served in the meeting room.
 - b. Non-Members pay £20.00 to gain entrance to the meeting. This fee includes drinks and light food served in the meeting room.
3. The dress code for all meetings is smart/causal.
4. Seemly conduct is required at all times.
5. Attendance at three Club meetings is required before any member can deliver a presentation to the group unless specifically requested by the Organisers.
6. There is an annual fee to become a member of the Tuesday Business Club.
 - a. This is currently charged at £35.00.
 - b. All memberships become due on the 1st May, and last 12 months.
 - c. If joining part way through a year, the full fee is payable.
7. Benefits of being a member may be varied over time, and currently include:
 - a. Reduced entrance fee to the monthly meetings
 - b. Ability to have a business profile added to the Tuesday Business Club website
 - c. An introduction slot in our monthly newsletter, circulated to all members and all attendees of a monthly meeting
 - d. Facility to circulate 'member-to-member' to all other members of the club, via the club Organisers
 - e. Facility to display marketing material at the monthly meetings
 - f. Opportunity to advertise workshops events etc. in TBC newsletters.
